



Apple Turkeys

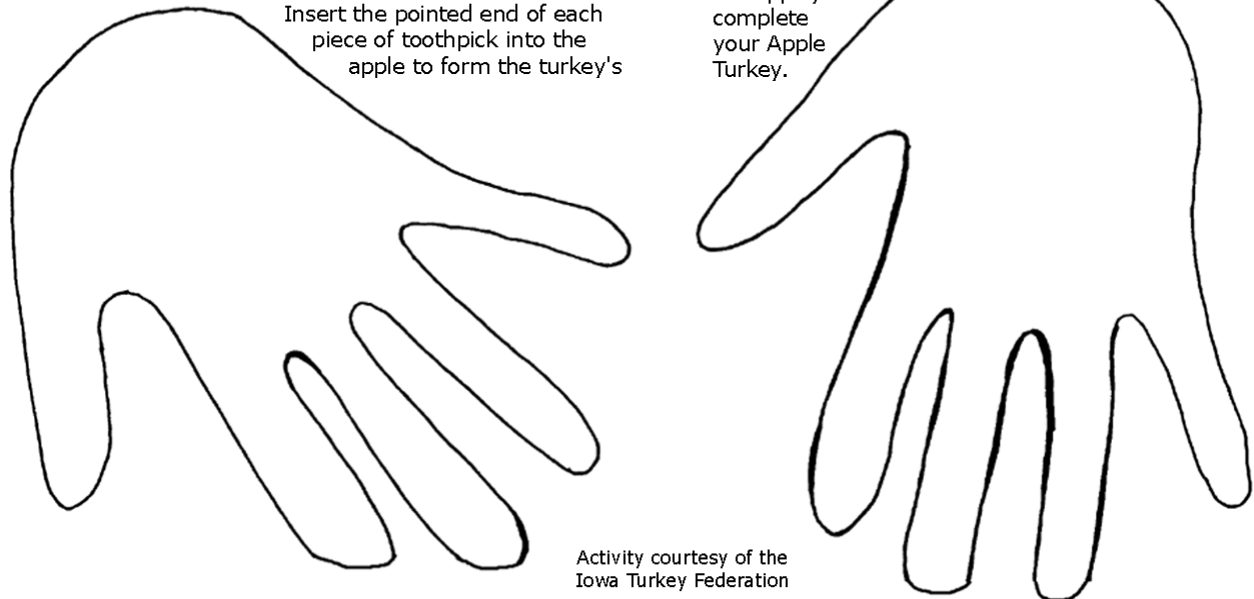
Supplies needed:

Crayons or colored pencils
Scissors
Toothpicks
Stapler
Apple



Directions:

1. Color turkey's head.
2. Either trace around your hand to make four handprints, or use the handprints on this sheet. Color hands. Each finger will be a different feather, so you might want to color them different colors.
3. Cut out the hands and the turkey head.
4. Lay the hand pieces on top of each other. Arrange them so that as many fingers show as possible. Staple them together once through the palm of the hand.
5. Place apple on its side. Break one toothpick in half. Insert the pointed end of each piece of toothpick into the apple to form the turkey's feet. If the feet are close enough together, the apple shouldn't roll.
6. Place the feathers (hands) at the back of the turkey (bottom of the apple). Run a toothpick through the hands and into the apple to hold them together.
7. Poke a toothpick through the dot at the back of the turkey's head and back out the dot at the front of the turkey's head. Insert this toothpick with the head into the front of the turkey (top of the apple) to complete your Apple Turkey.
